

- **Multi-stakeholder** platform
 - To provide **100% energy access** for all through **renewable energy** in Sumba by **2025**
 - **Formalized** by the Government of Indonesia through Minister Energy and Mineral Resources (MEMR) Decree dated June 1st 2015
 - Gender situation in 2013
 - **Valuable assets** are jointly owned by both husband & wife
 - Tendency that male/husband has higher **access to asset** than wife
 - Dominant role of male in **selection of energy used**, children education, use of agriculture/husbandry, etc.



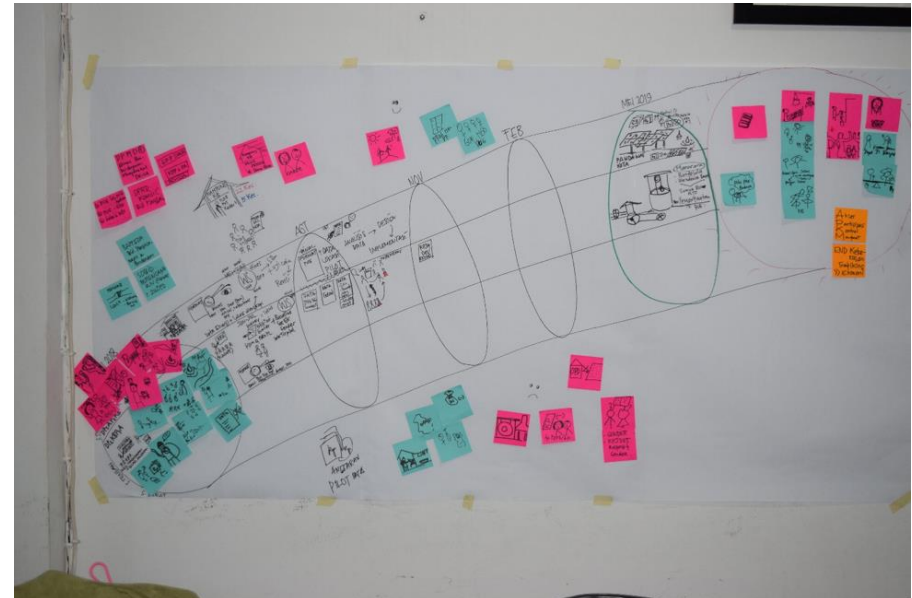
Sumba Island

- 750,000 in population (2015)
- Part of East Nusa Tenggara province, which is the poorest of the 33 Indonesian provinces (Nominal GRP capita per year \$1,288)

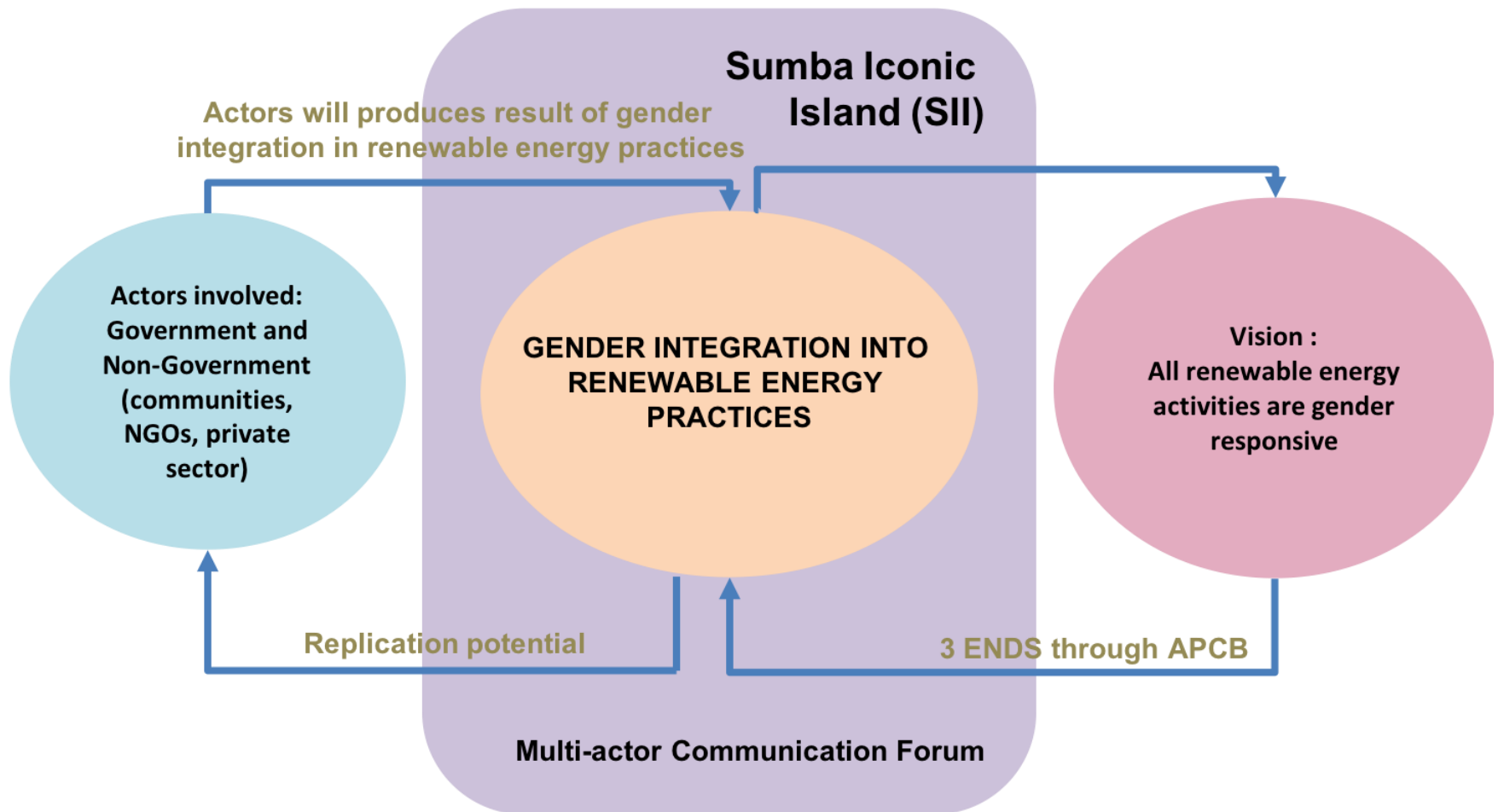




Currently, we are working with the local Government to make a model on gender integration in renewable energy sector
