We are coordinated by a Central Secretariat in Geneva, Switzerland




#### Three main challenges...

#### ISO Standards: enabling energy resilience

#### Planning and risk reduction

Standards for risk & vulnerability assessment, business continuity planning

#### Recovery and adaptation

Standards that support renewable integration and disaster response

#### Interoperability and safety

Standards that ensure reliable, safe, connected systems

#### **Design and operation**

Standards for durability, grid stability, decentralization

#### **Facilitating transitions**

Standards for energy management, hydrogen and smart grids

#### **Policy and finance**

Standards that enable regulation and de-risk investments


## Capacity building: sustaining systems

- Standards are powerful—but only if people and institutions can apply them, and benefit from them.
- Capacity building makes standards actionable, relevant, and locally owned.
- We work with national standards bodies (NSBs), ministries, engineers, academia, industry, civil society and other stakeholders to ensure developing countries:
  - Participate in international standardization
  - Increase the uptake of ISO standards that contribute to the achievement of the SGDs, in the public/private sectors
- Technical assistance, training, knowledge sharing, and regional cooperation are at the heart of our approach.
